Axis Deer (Axis axis) are medium sized deer ranging from male weights of 145 to 250 lbs and female weights from 95 to 145 lbs. Axis have a characteristic white bib at their throat and a black dorsal stripe (down their back). Axis are originally from India and thrive in mild climates such as South Texas and Texas Hill Country. Axis are able to breed year round, and individually bucks are reproductive at different times. At one time, you may have animals in your herd in various reproductive cycles. You can have bucks with cleaned, hardened antlers ready to mate, does in heat and animals not in rutting state. Although it has been reported that bucks can mate in velvet, it is believed that hard antlered Axis generally are competitive and keep bucks in velvet from mating. Gestation is approximately 7 1/2 months and Axis typically have one young at birth.
